



## Ankeny Little League Baseball Parents and Friends

ANKENY LLB will begin our registration process for all Ankeny area players that are **five years (5) through sixteen years (16)** of age, who would like to participate in the Little League Program. The ALLB Board has set the '2012' registration to begin **January 1, 2012** and close the regular registration on **February 18, 2012** for ages **9 through 16**. The regular registration for ages **5 through 8** will open **January 1, 2012** and close **March 18, 2012**. A \$25 late fee will be assessed for registering after the close of the regular registration. The minimum age to participate in Ankeny LLB requires the player to be 5 years of age by September 15, 2012.

We are hopeful that the majority of our players will register **On-Line** through our web site at [www.ankenyllb.com](http://www.ankenyllb.com) or [www.ankenylittleleague.com](http://www.ankenylittleleague.com). The parent should use your previous Login name and password or register your name and password if you are a first time user. The registration fees may be paid with a credit/debit card. Also, we will provide **walk-in** registration at the location listed on the back of this flyer. Ankeny LL will **not** accept **mail-in** registrations this year. New players to the Ankeny Little League are asked to provide a copy of the player's 'Birth Certificate'. This can be provided by either showing the birth certificate at the walk-in registration, or e-mailing a pdf copy or mailing a copy (do not mail original) of the birth certificate to our mailing address: P.O. Box 165, Ankeny, IA 50021. Personal checks will be accepted for anyone desiring to use this form of payment for the registration fee.

The '2012' Registration and Volunteer Fees are listed on the back of this flyer. The Volunteer Fee was established three years ago, in response to the feedback that the league received, to provide an efficient and accountable method for parents to pay for concession stand duties. This Volunteer Fee allows for an easy method to pay for concession workers but allows parents to receive a \$25 reimbursement by volunteering and completing one of the following duties:

- Working one 3-hour session in the concession stand (work time must be scheduled on-line)
- Managing one of the Little League teams
- Serving as a Team Parent including completing and returning the team raffle packet.

Also, the Board adopted a resolution to provide **free** registration for players, if one of the player's parents is deployed in active duty with the Armed Forces.
